

13. Adjustment




1. Assemble the Base




- Insert the right leg into the base. Align the holes in the right leg to the holes in the base. Secure with the screws. Repeat this step for the left leg.




Attach the column to the base using the screws . Tighten all screws using an Allen key.



7. Installing the Adapter Brackets






7a. Attach TV Bracket to Flat Back Screen










7b. Attach TV Bracket to Curved or Recessed Back Screen




Note: Choose the appropriate screws, washers and spacers (if necessary) according to the type of screen.

Tighten all screws but do not over tighten.


